



Remote Learning Survey **Outcomes and Actions**

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Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to those parents/carers who completed the Remote Learning Survey. We had 65 responses in total which represents around 50% of our school community who are currently accessing school work remotely. Please find the main findings below with some suggestions and actions included.

Remote Learning Survey Outcomes

How clear is the work which the school sets for your child?

67% - very clear
33% - clear

How often do technical issues disrupt your child's learning?

78% - occasionally
13% - weekly
9% - daily

If your child is experiencing technical issues with the device they are using to access Remote Learning, please contact either the class teacher, school office or the enquiries email address enquiries@bassingham.school.org and we will help you to overcome any issues.

In general, how satisfied are you with the remote learning provided by school?

63% - very happy
36% - happy
1% - unhappy

How clear has the communication from the school been during the current remote learning period?

82% - very clear
18% - clear

In general, how confident are you with supporting your child's remote learning at home?

35% - very confident
39% - confident
22% - developing confidence
4% - not confident

If you require any help or guidance with supporting your child's Remote Learning, please contact your child's class teacher. Teachers will be happy to address any difficulties and offer guidance to parents where required.

From your observations, how well is your child/children coping with the current situation?

37% - they are coping well
52% - they are coping
11% - they are not coping well

Remote Learning Survey Actions

Having listened to wider feedback from parents/carers, some common themes emerged with how our Remote Learning offer could be improved further. Please find some actions and next steps identified below.

Pupil Feedback:

- Via Purple Mash, all pupils will be set a weekly 'To Do' task which they can hand in for their teachers to look at. Teachers will then provide written feedback for the children to see on a weekly basis.
- Children will be encouraged to show examples of their work at the end of lessons using the camera on their devices at home. This will allow us to monitor pupil engagement.
- Teachers will continue to provide whole class feedback during lessons and encourage the children to self-assess their work where possible.
- Children can also continue emailing/sending examples of their completed work to their teachers so that this can be reviewed and looked at.

Extension Activities:

- Teachers will provide optional extension activities for pupils, particularly in Maths, if they require additional work or challenges.
- Once again, please contact your child's class teacher for any queries regarding additional work.

Physical Education:

- Friday afternoon will be used as our 'Get Active' time where pupils will be given a choice of activities to complete that will keep them fit and healthy!
